G.S.R. -- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'A' post of Chief Commissioner of Railway Safety in the Commission of Railway Safety under the Ministry of Civil Aviation , namely :-

- 1. Short title and commencement:-** (1) These rules may be called the Railway Inspectorate Service [Chief Commissioner of Railway Safety] Recruitment Rules, 2019.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, Classification and Pay Band and Grade Pay or Pay Scale:-**The number of the said posts, its classification and the level of pay in pay matrix are attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualification, etc:-** The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification-** No person,
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:
Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
- 5. Power to relax-** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of person or posts.
- 6. Saving-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limits and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-servicemen ,the other Backward Classes, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Promotion:

Commissioner of Railway Safety or Commissioner of Metro Railway Safety having three years regular service in the grade.

Note 1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Note 2: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an office prior to **1st January, 2016 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Seventh Central Pay Commission** recommendation has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding Grade Pay/Pay Scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission.
