Subject:- Filling up of one post of Staff Car Driver, Ordinary Grade in the office of the Technical Wing ,Commission of Railway Safety Headquarter, Lucknow.

Applications are invited from eligible Central Govt. Employees to fill up the post of Staff Car Driver Ordinary Grade in the office of the Technical Wing , Commission of Railway Safety Headquarter, Lucknow under Ministry of Civil Aviation as per details given below:-

Essential Qualifications: 1. Possession of a valid Driving Licence for Motor Car. 2. Knowledge of motor mechanism. 3. Three years of experience of driving a motor car. Desirable Qualification: 1. Middle Standard Pass.

Note

- 1: The age limit should be between 21 to 30 years (relaxable upto 35 years in case of Central Government servants.) as on the closing date of receipt of application.
2. Applications of willing officers, fulfilling the above conditions may please be forwarded along with.
 - (i) Bio-Data (in duplicate)
 - (ii) Photocopies of ACRs for the last five years duly attested on each page by an officer not below the rank of Under Secretary to the Govt. Of India.
 - (iii) Vigilance Clearance Certificate.

- (iv) Integrity Certificate.
- (v)w A statement giving details of major/minor penalties imposed on the officer, if any during last 10 years.
3. The Pay & allowances of the selected officer shall be regulated as per DoPT's OM. No. -6/8/2009-Estt (Pay-II) dated.-17.06.2010 as amended from time to time. Officers who volunteer for the post will not be permitted to withdraw their names subsequently.
 4. In addition to entitled LTC, one set of complementary Railway Pass and one set of Privilege Ticket Order of appropriate class in a year will be given to the employee so appointed in the Commission of Railway Safety, during the period of deputation. However, for Railway employees the normal pass rules will apply.
 5. It is requested that the applications (in duplicate) of willing and eligible officers may be forwarded to the office of **Deputy Commissioner of Railway Safety (M), Technical Wing ,Commission of Railway Safety Headquarter, DRM/ NER Compound Ashok Marg, Lucknow-226001**, by 20.04.2017 While forwarding the application, it may also be verified and certified by the employer that the particulars furnished by the applicant(s) are correct.
 6. The candidates will not be allowed to withdraw their names in the event of their selection.
 7. The applications received after the closing date or other than through proper channel or without ACRs and other certificates as required, will not be entertained.
